### **Description, contents, learning-outcomes :**

At the end of this course, student should be able to :

- Understand the social sciences approaches applied to the study of the city, their particularities and their methods
- Account for the nature and changing character of the city and the urban experience - including the larger social, political, and economic dynamics of urban change
- Apply the tools of the human and social sciences as part of a territorial diagnosis

### **Content :**

- Urban geography : the birth of urban planning (definition of the city as a system, geographical division and functionalities)
- Urban sociology : School of Chicago and contemporary analysis (analysis of the city as a living organism, interactions of communities, study of margins, etc.)
- Urban anthropology : Ulf Hannerz and recent works (analysis of social interactions, roles, and networks of city dwellers)
- Social sciences at the service of territorial diagnosis : what tools, what methods?
